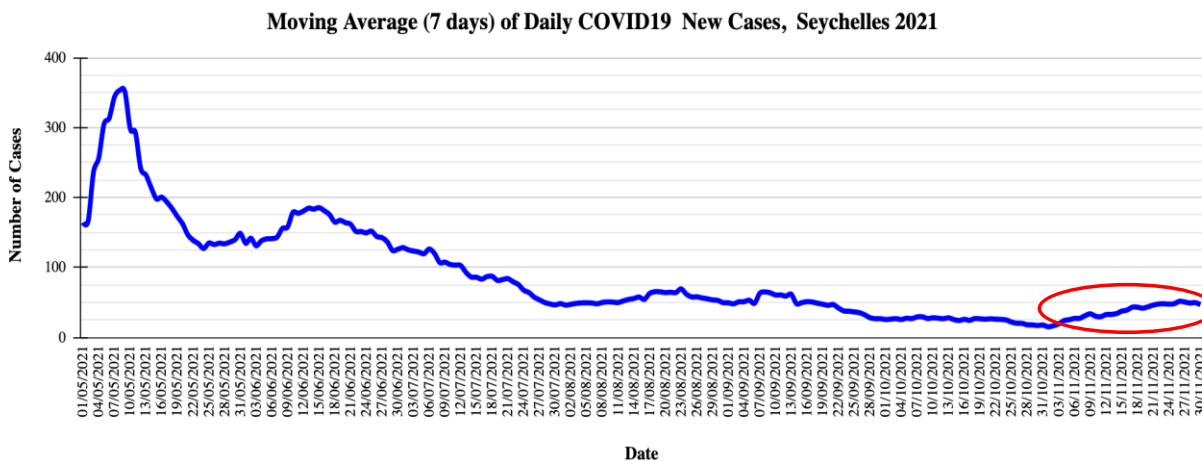

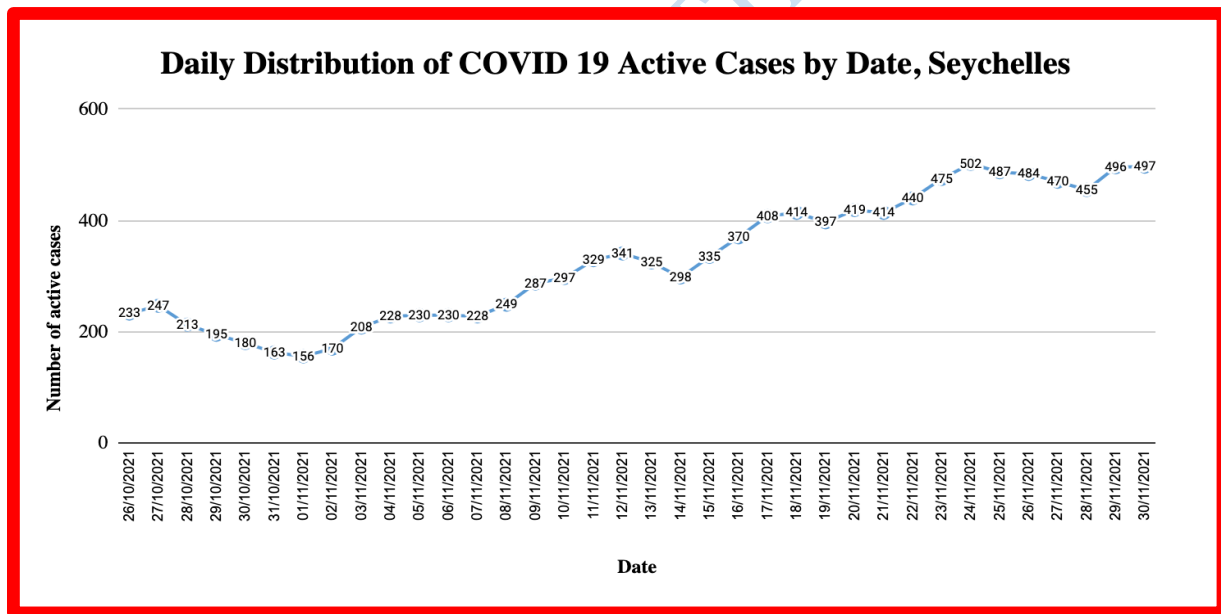
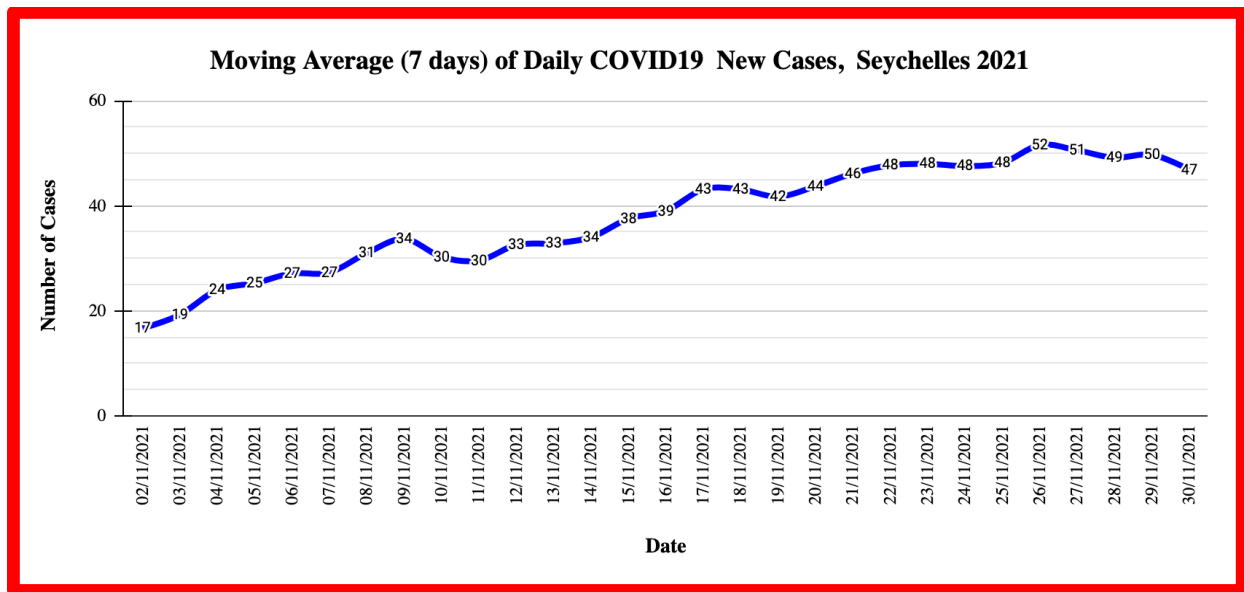
#### Covid-19 Update

The Ministry of Health continues to see a sustained community transmission of COVID-19. Presently there are 497 active cases in the country and the 7-day rolling average is 47.

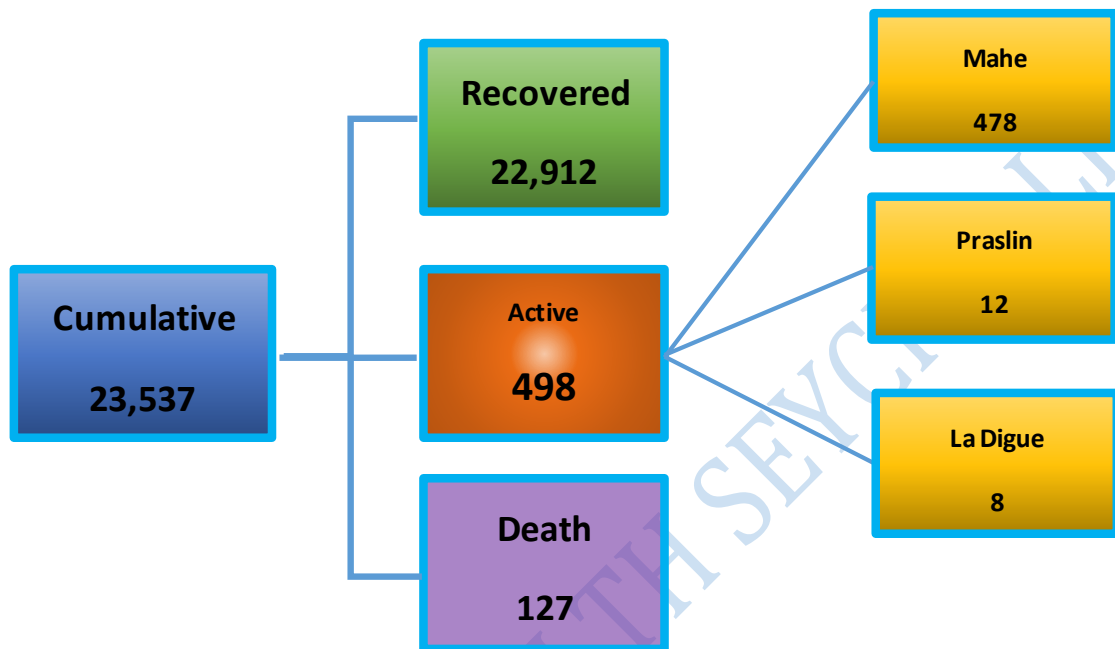
The graph below shows the 7 day moving average from 1<sup>st</sup> May to 30<sup>th</sup> November 2021.

The chart below shows the total number of cases ever reported, the number recovered, active cases and death. It also depicts the distribution of active cases for Mahe, Praslin and La Digue.
