### Covid-19 Update


The Ministry of Health continues to see a sustained community transmission of COVID-19. Presently there are 497 active cases in the country and the 7-day rolling average is 47.


The graph below shows the 7 day moving average from 1st May to 30th November 2021.

#### Moving Average (7 days) of Daily COVID19 New Cases, Seychelles 2021


