



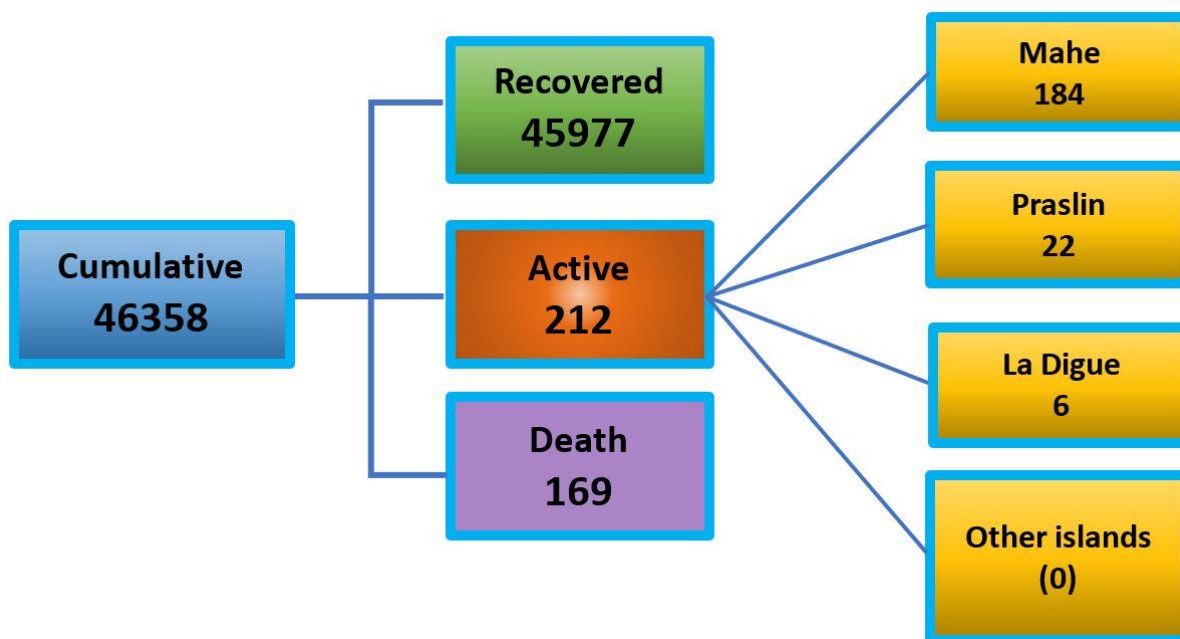

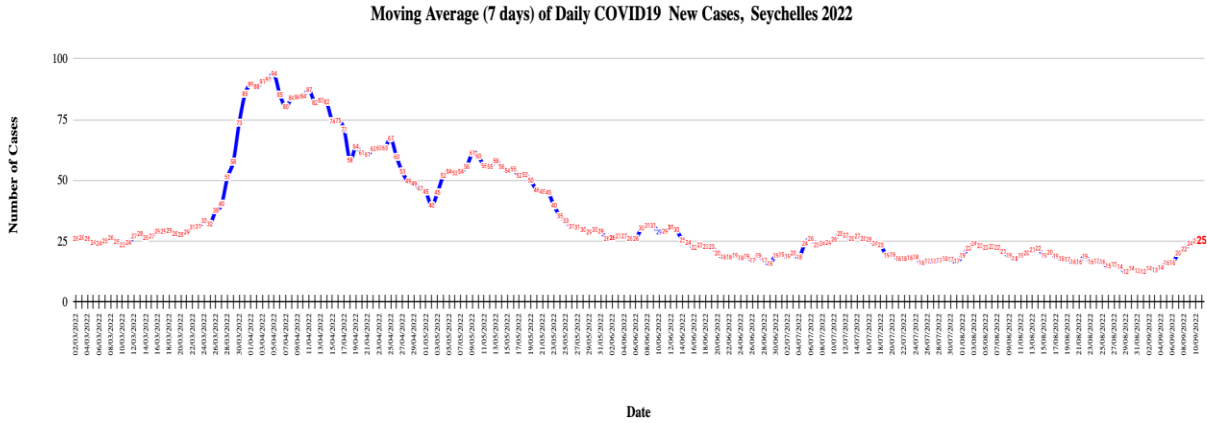
### Covid-19 Update

Cumulative cases of COVID -19, status and distribution by location up to 11<sup>th</sup> September 2022

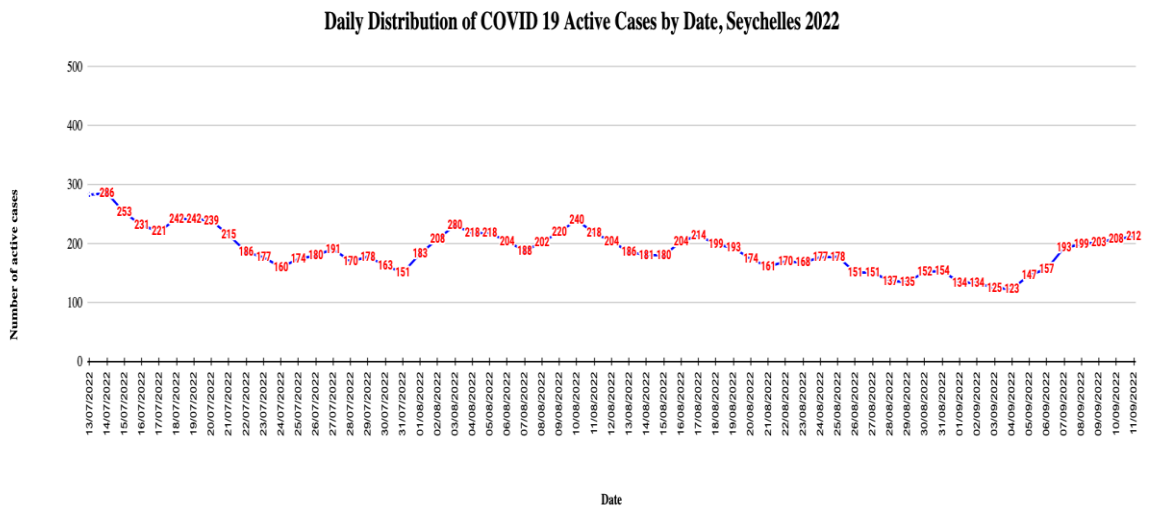


- The number of new COVID-19 infection has been increasing steadily this past week and the 7-day rolling average is now 25 cases, up from 13 same time last week.
- The total number of active cases is now 212, almost 100 more than last week.
- The highest number of reported current active cases is in Au Cap and Beau Vallon with 18 and 17 cases respectively.
- Presently there are no patients admitted at the COVID-19 treatment facilities.
- The public is advised to take personal responsibility to prevent infection.
- Vaccination against COVID-19 is available at specific health facilities.
  - Do come forward for your next dose if due.
