<p>Notes</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Conditions for stay for Children up to age 17 will be as for the parent/guardian they accompany during travel to Seychelles. All individuals arriving in Seychelles must report any illness to their local health centre and/or public health authority, even if vaccinated. Any traveller may be requested to have a Covid-19 test for surveillance purposes Diplomats follow conditions as for Seychellois and Residents. Unvaccinated Seafarers arriving by flight may choose to do their arrival quarantine on a vessel with approval of the Public Health Authority. Conditions for arrival by sea (Super-Yachts or other vessels) remain the same, until future announcements.
