Update on COVID-19 cases

71 new cases of COVID-19 were recorded since the last update provided in the interview on Friday 05th February bringing the total number of cases recorded in Seychelles to 1504. The samples were taken on the 4th and 5th February.

45 cases have met the discharge criteria and have been released into convalescence.

The information and circumstances surrounding this surge of COVID-19 cases are being analysed and further details will be provided in the coming days.

Health authorities urge members of the public to diligently observe all preventive and public health measures in place.
