Update on COVID-19 cases

119 new cases of COVID-19 were recorded since the last update bringing the total number of cases recorded in Seychelles to 1695.

Of the new cases, 85 are from samples taken on the 8th, 9 from 7th, 9 from the 6th and 16 from the 5th of February.

17 cases (4 foreigners and 13 Seychellois) met discharge criteria today and have been discharged into convalescence.
