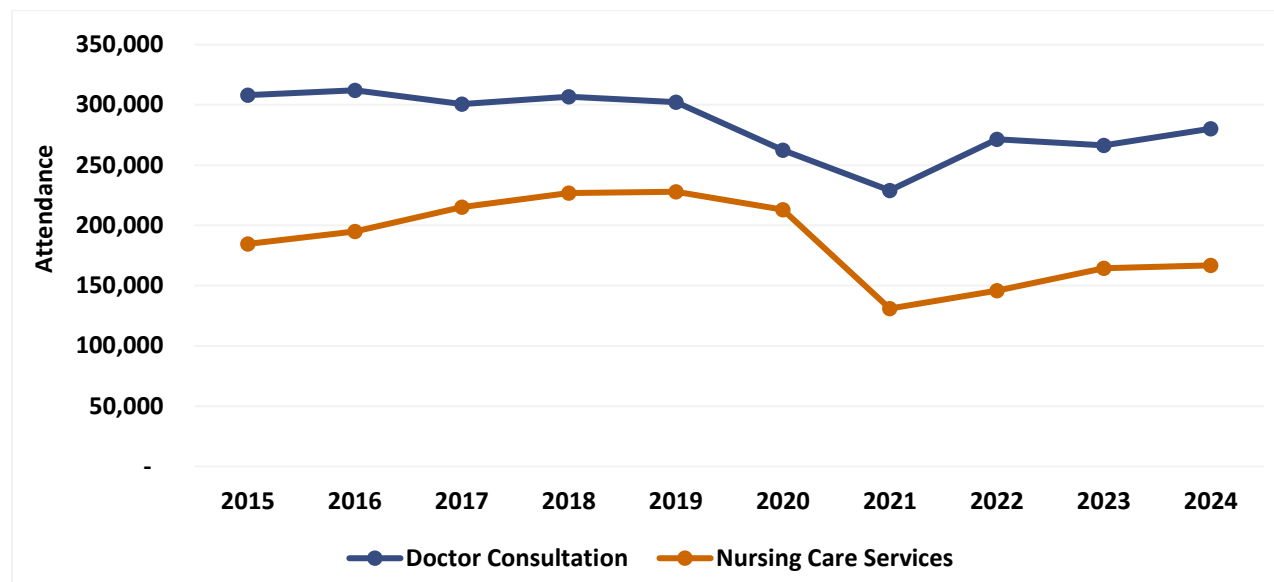

Figure 1 Doctor Consultation and Nursing Care Services Attendance, 2015-2024

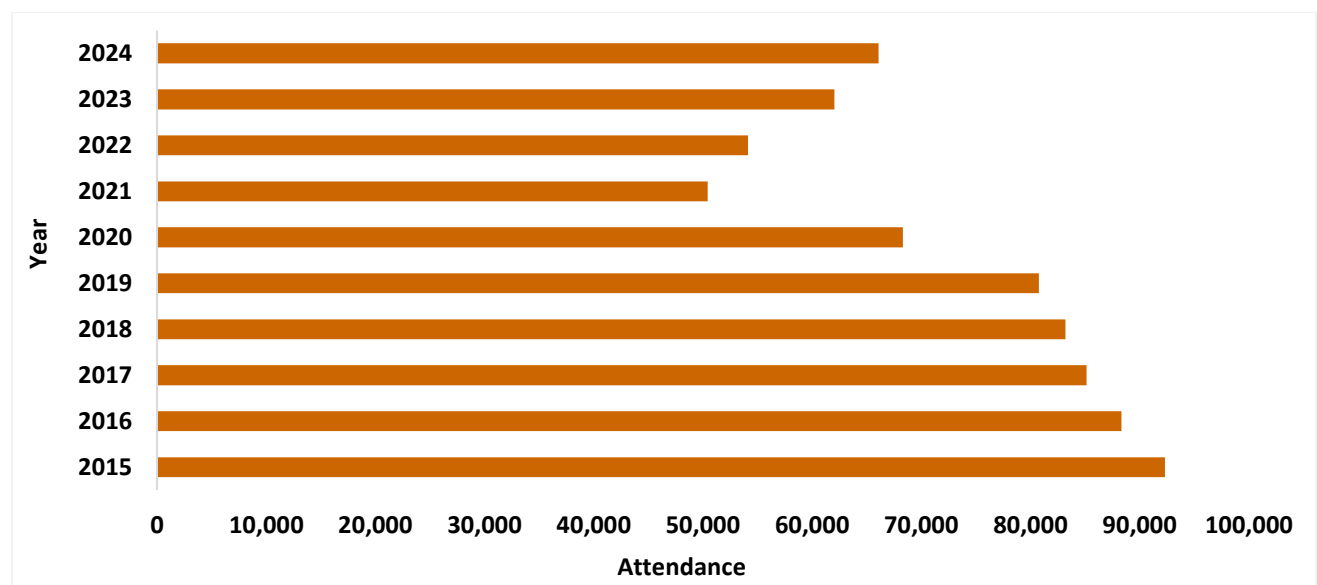

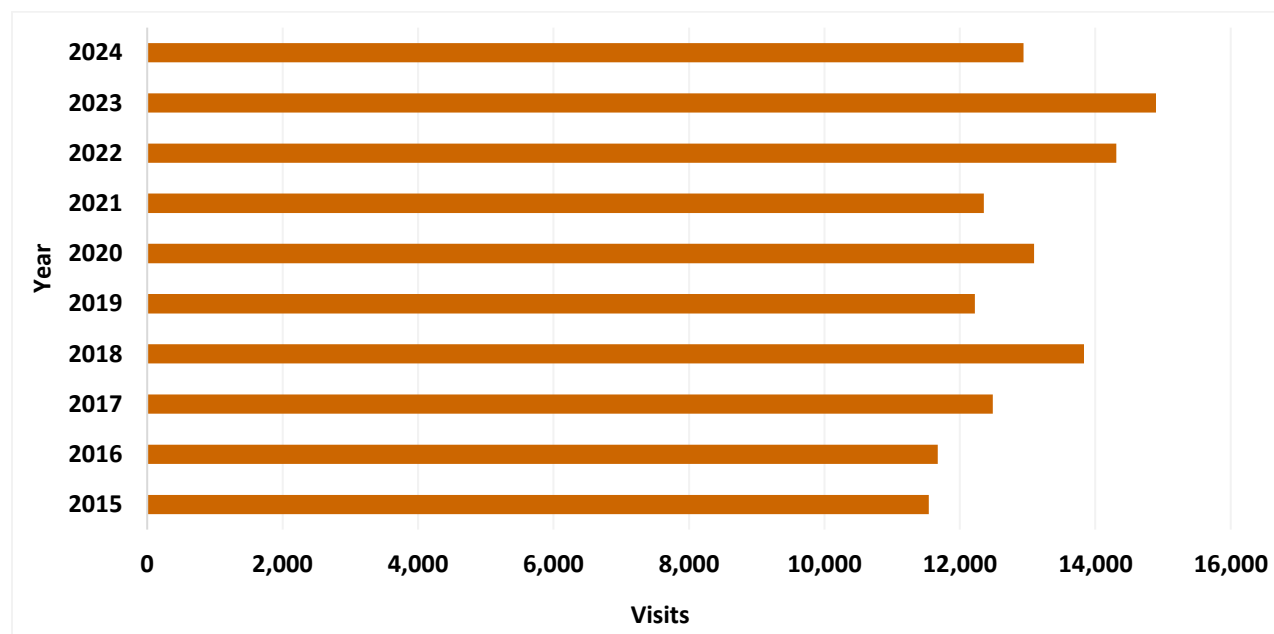

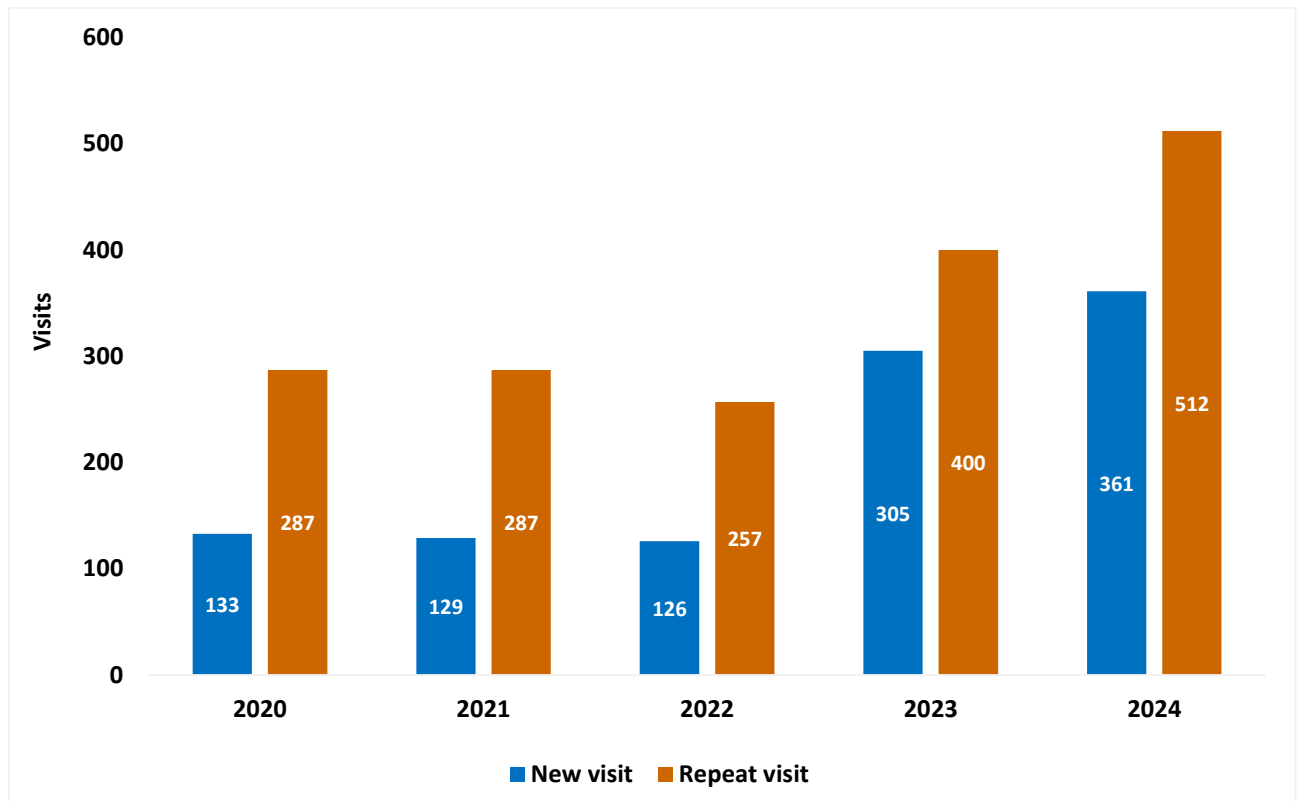

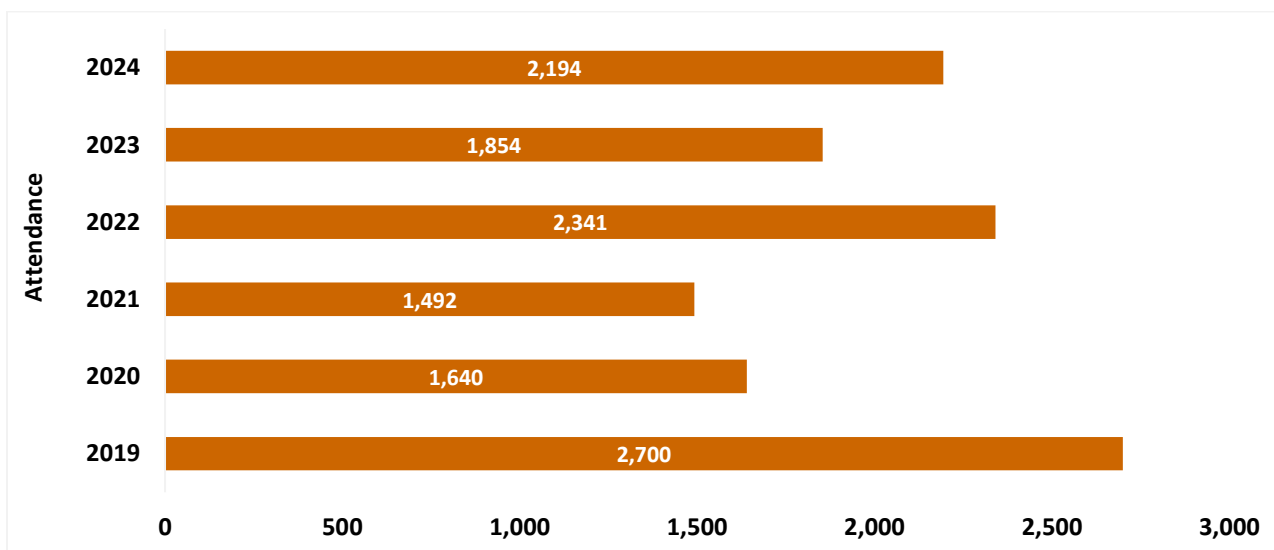

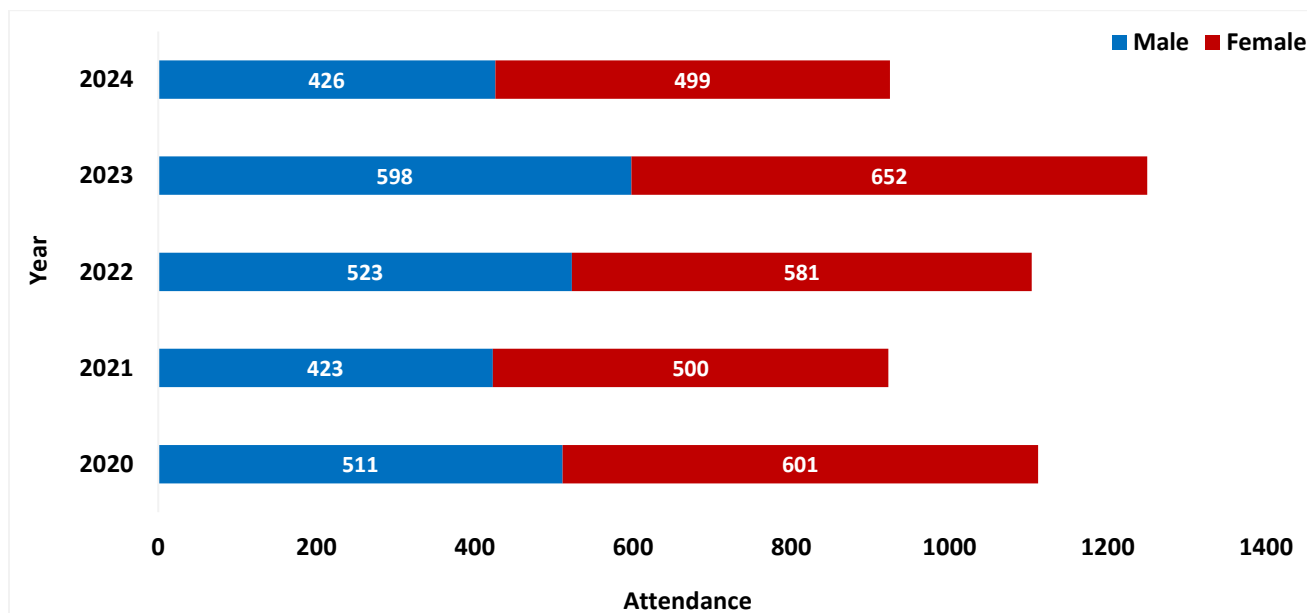

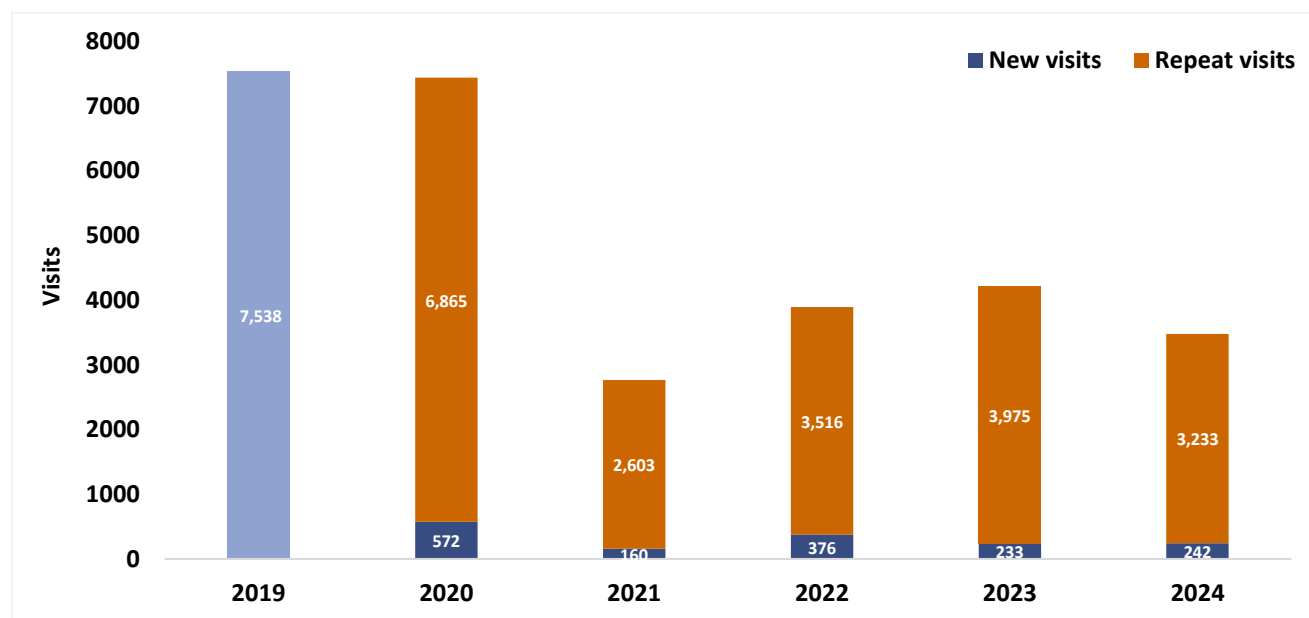

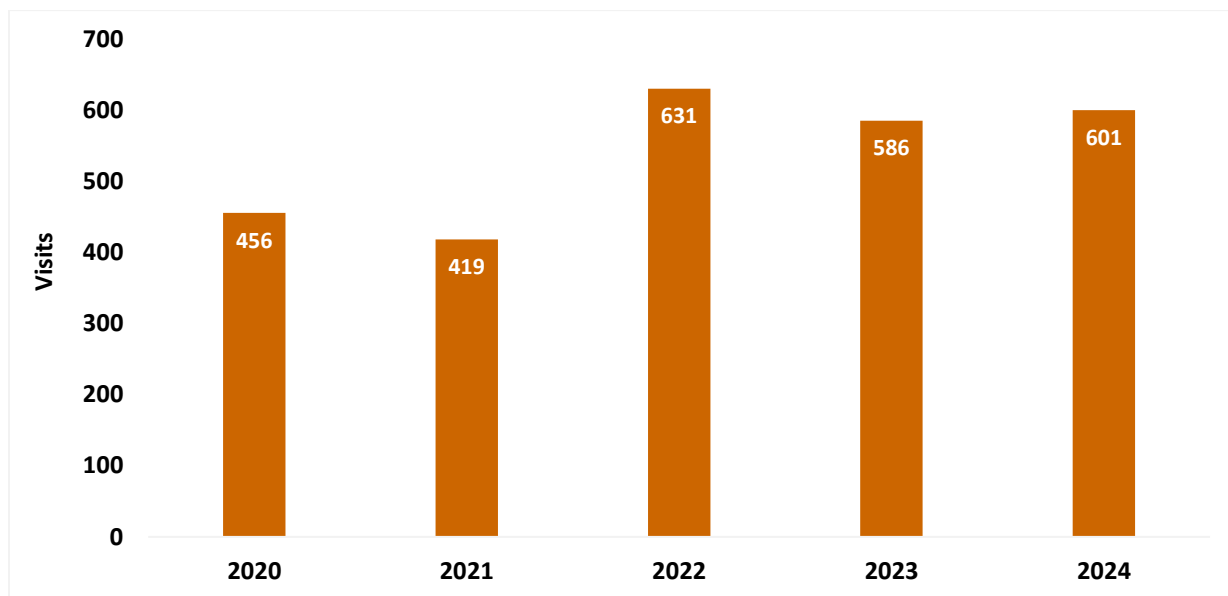

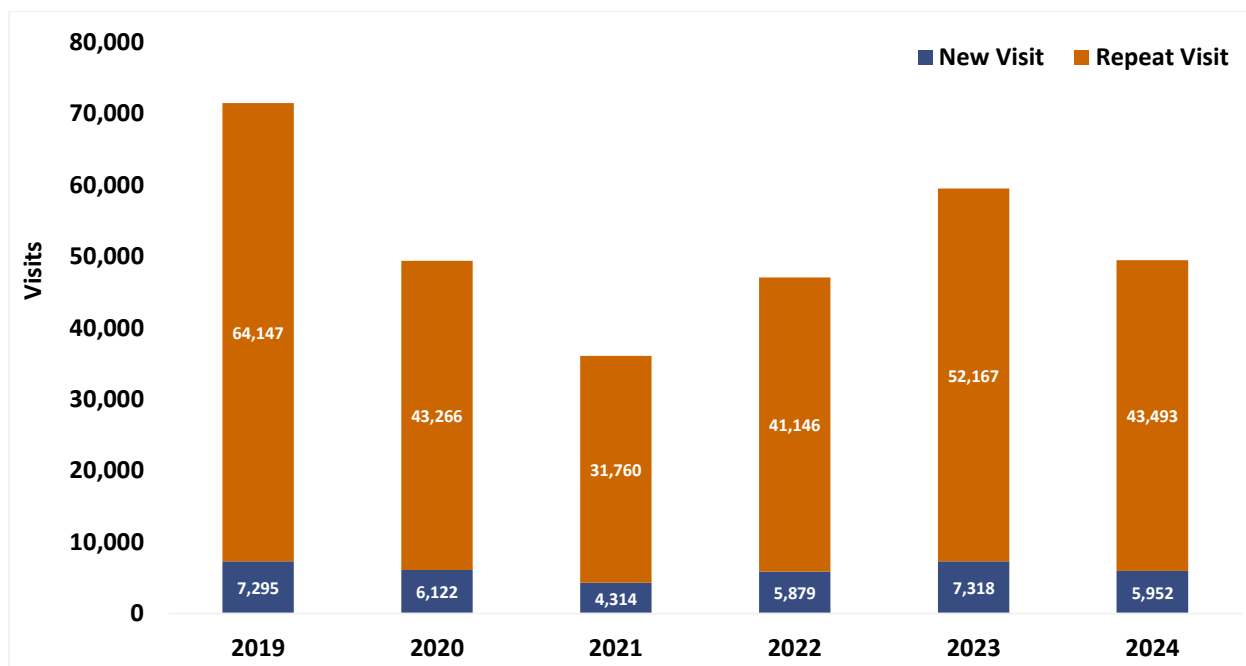
Figure 7 Visits for Orthoprosthesis Services, 2020 - 2024

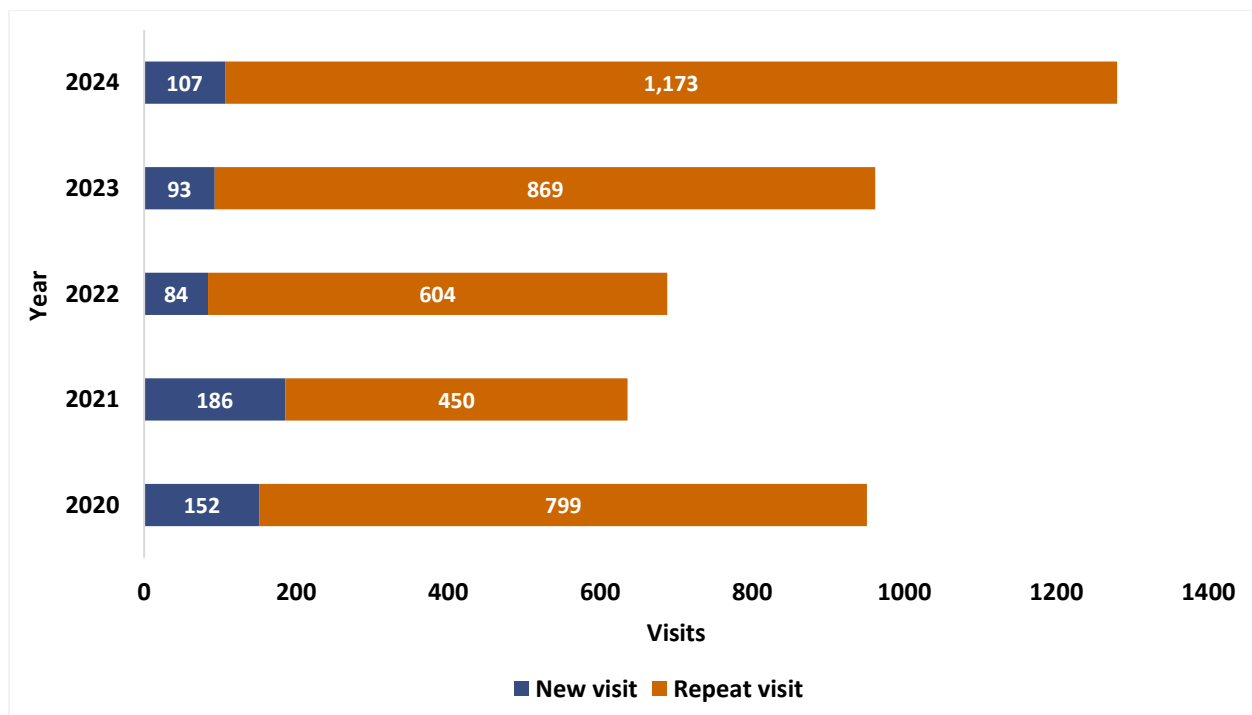

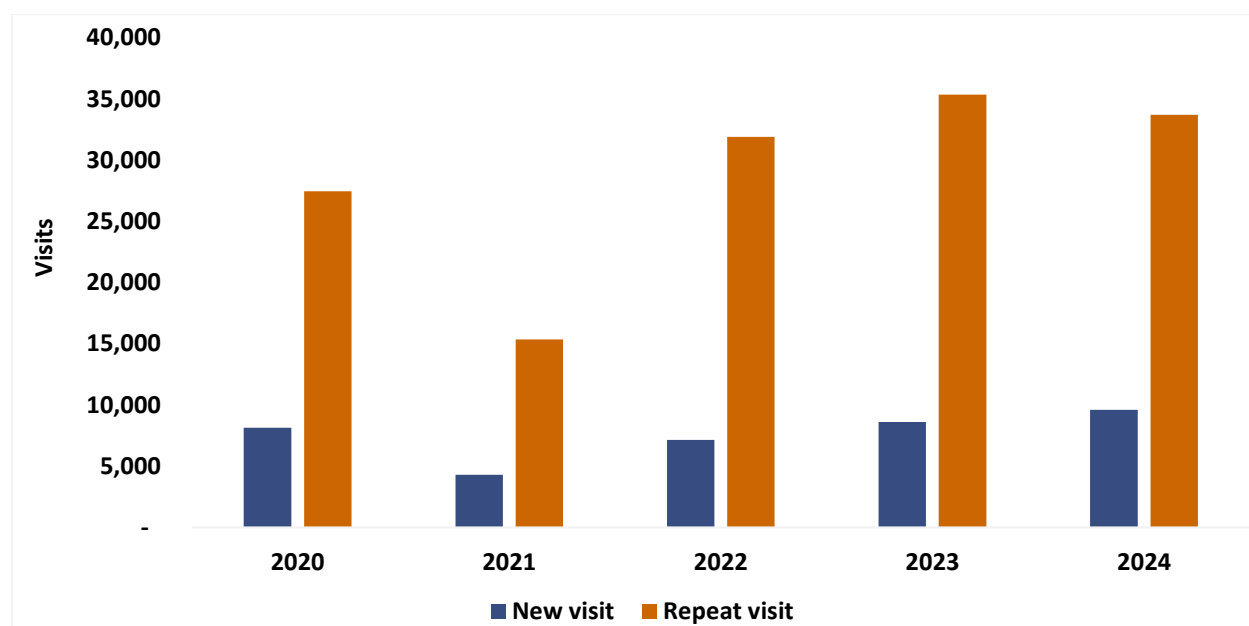

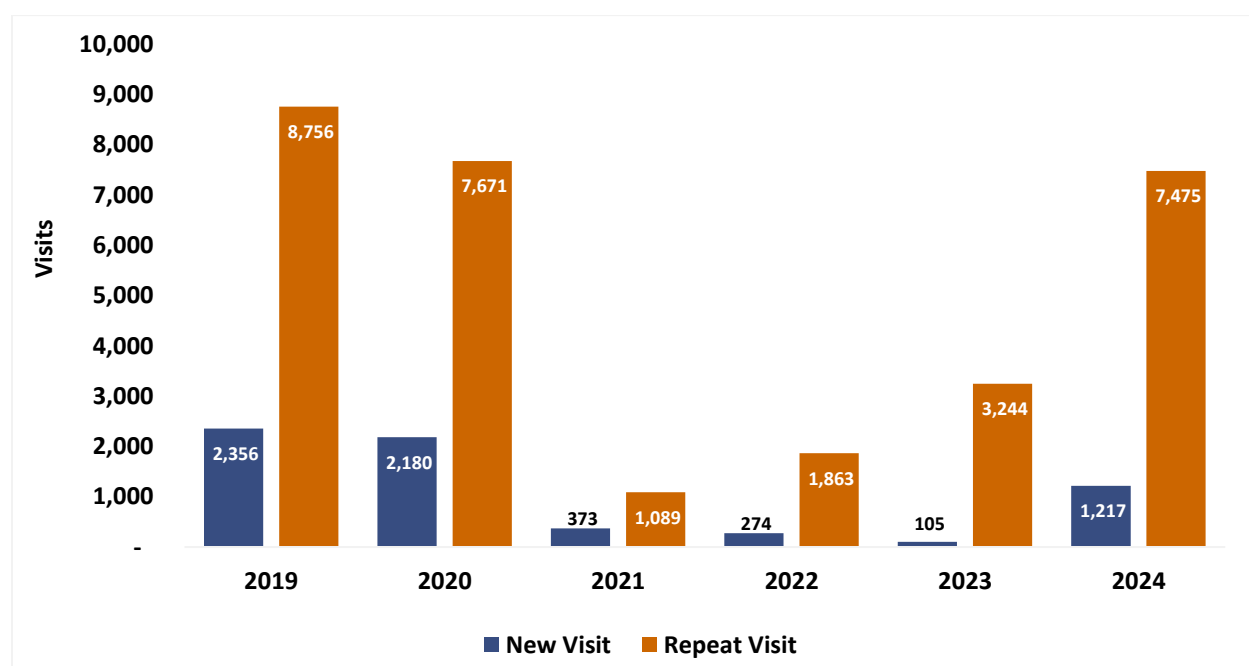
Figure 10 SOPD Attendance (new and repeat visits), 2020-2024

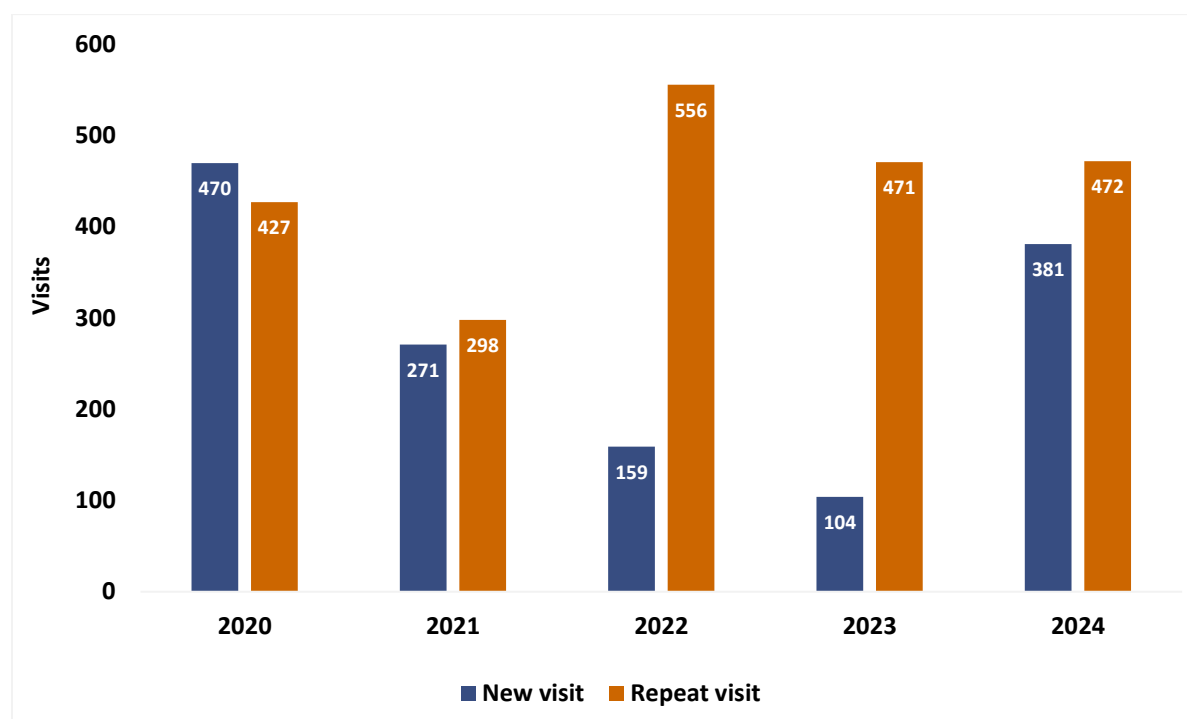

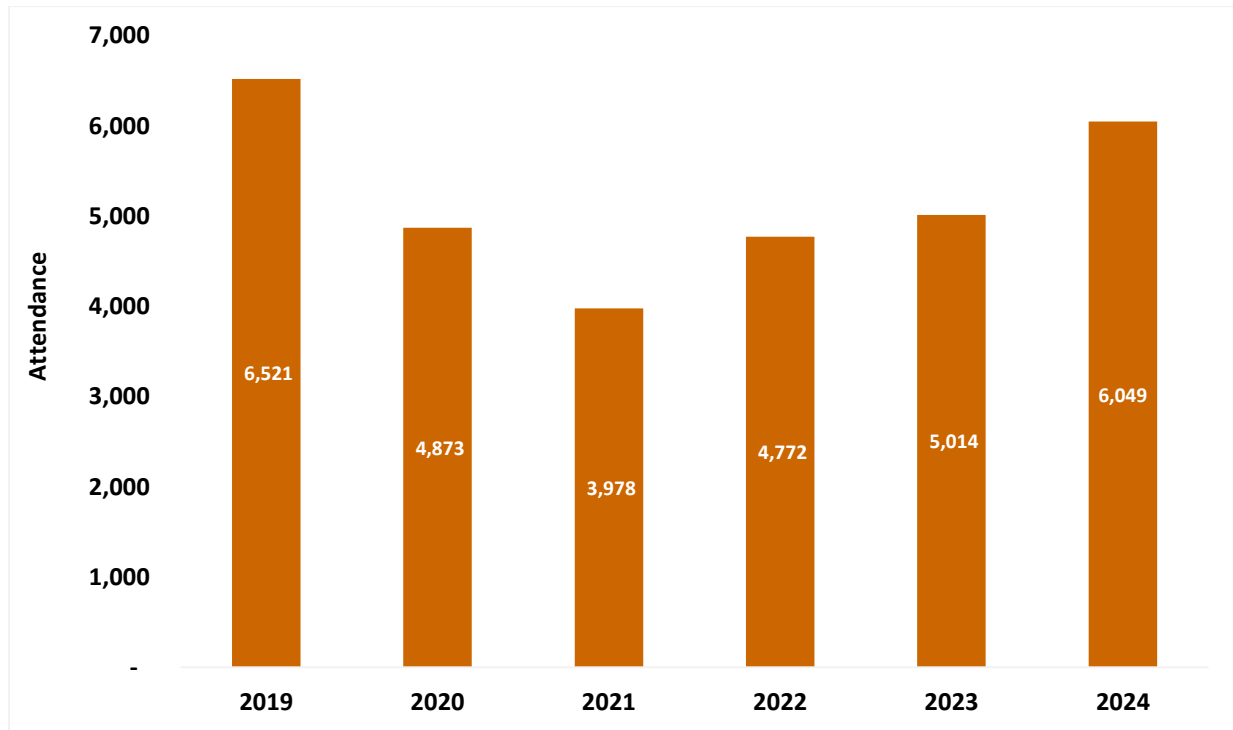
