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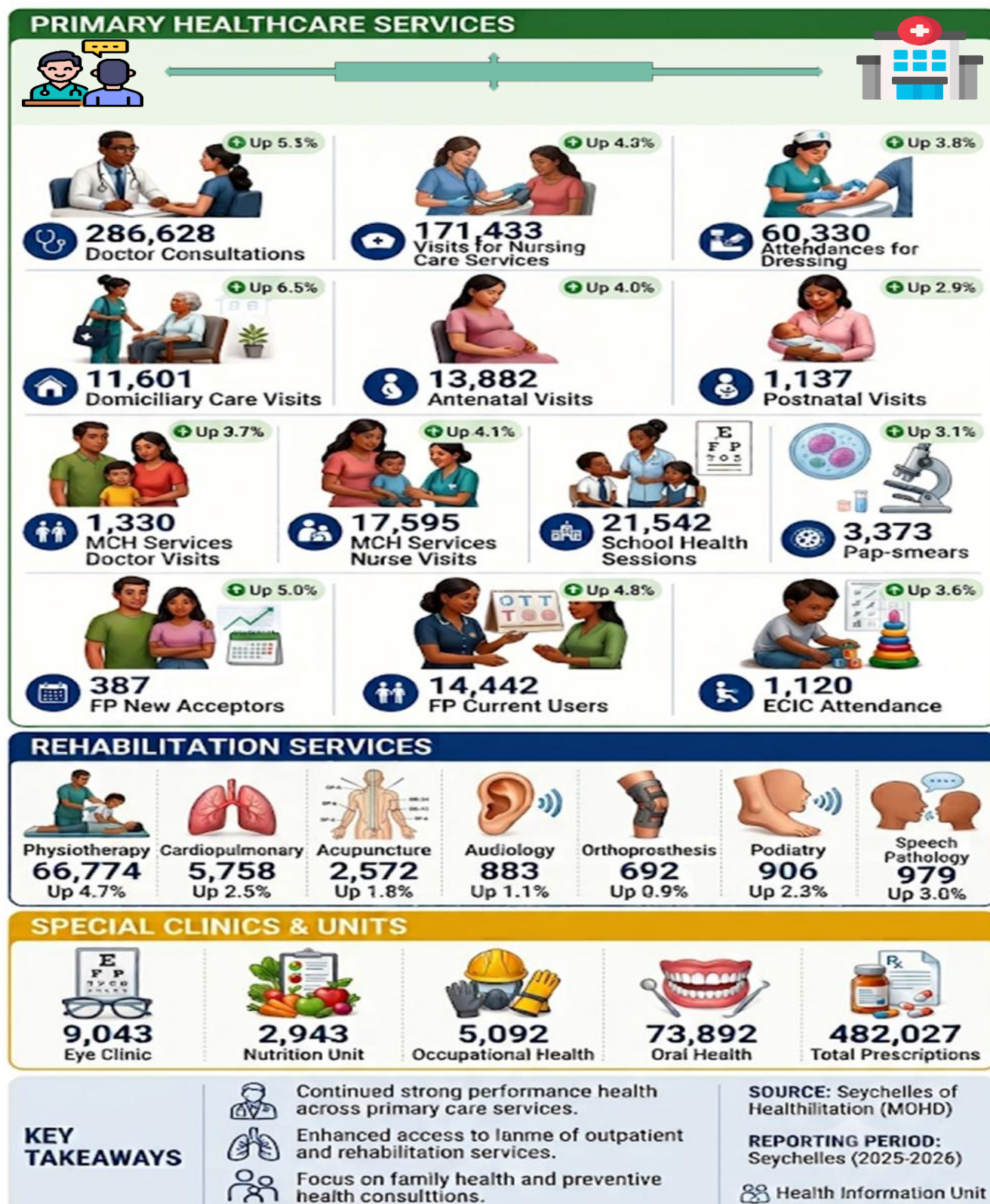

Preface

Primary Healthcare can be defined as essential healthcare made accessible at a cost a country and community can afford, with methods that are practical, scientifically sound, and socially acceptable¹. In Seychelles, Primary Healthcare (PHC) services are delivered through a network of health and rehabilitation facilities nationwide, complemented by targeted intervention programmes designed to achieve specific health improvement goals for citizens.

This report presents key statistics for the year 2025, derived primarily from health facilities (mostly public) providing Primary Healthcare (PHC) services, along with data from select specialized clinics and units. It also serves as an evidence-based resource for PHC service providers to summarize their achievements and inform the public about the progress made in 2025.

The statistics in this report are primarily descriptive and strictly based on data collected and submitted by relevant health facilities and units within the specified reporting timeline. Additionally, the report places significant emphasis on service utilization.

We extend our appreciation to the management and staff of all health facilities and units for their support and contributions to this report. We look forward to continued successful collaborations in future editions.

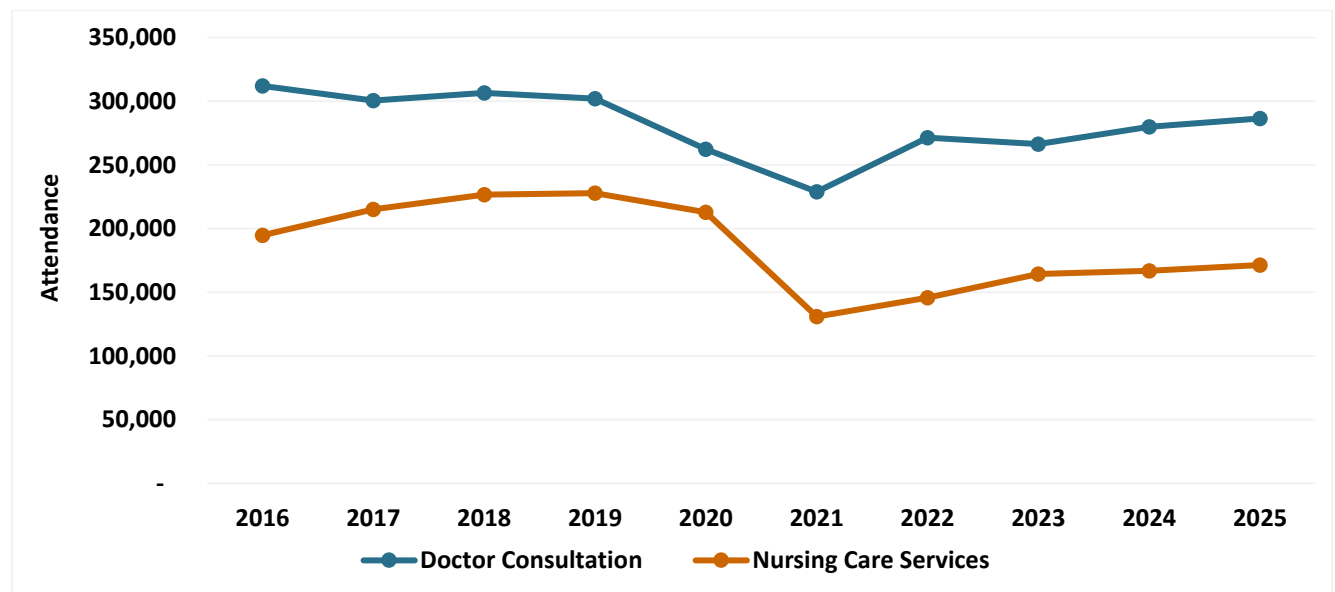

Figure 1 Doctor Consultation and Nursing Care Services Attendance, 2016-2025

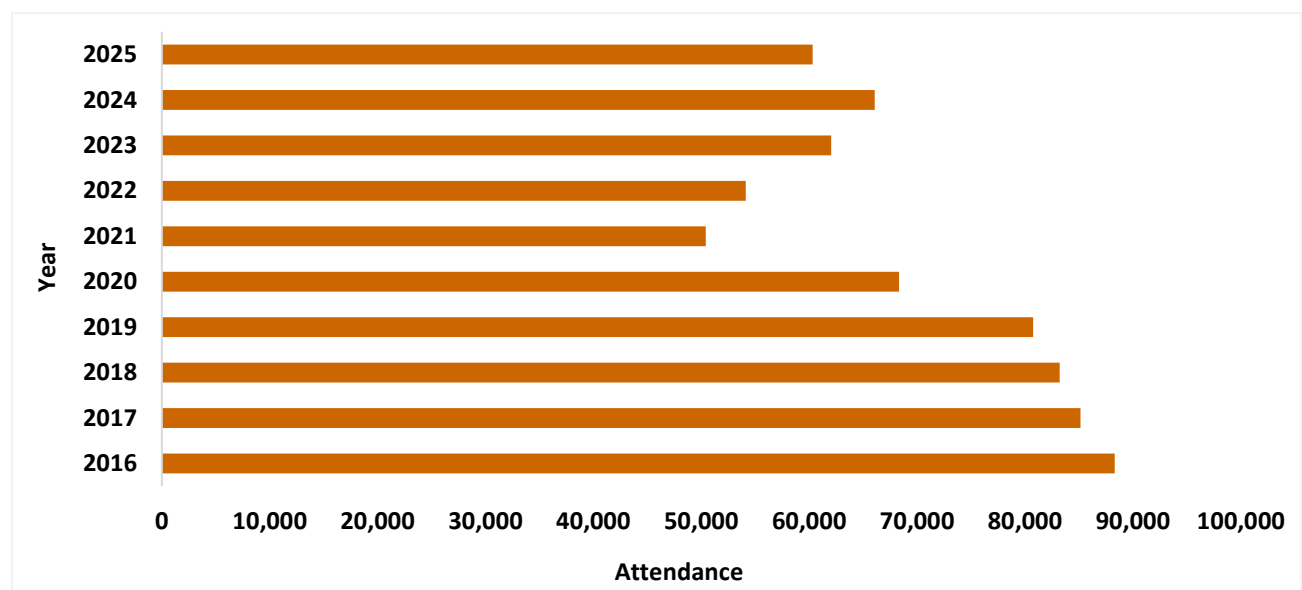

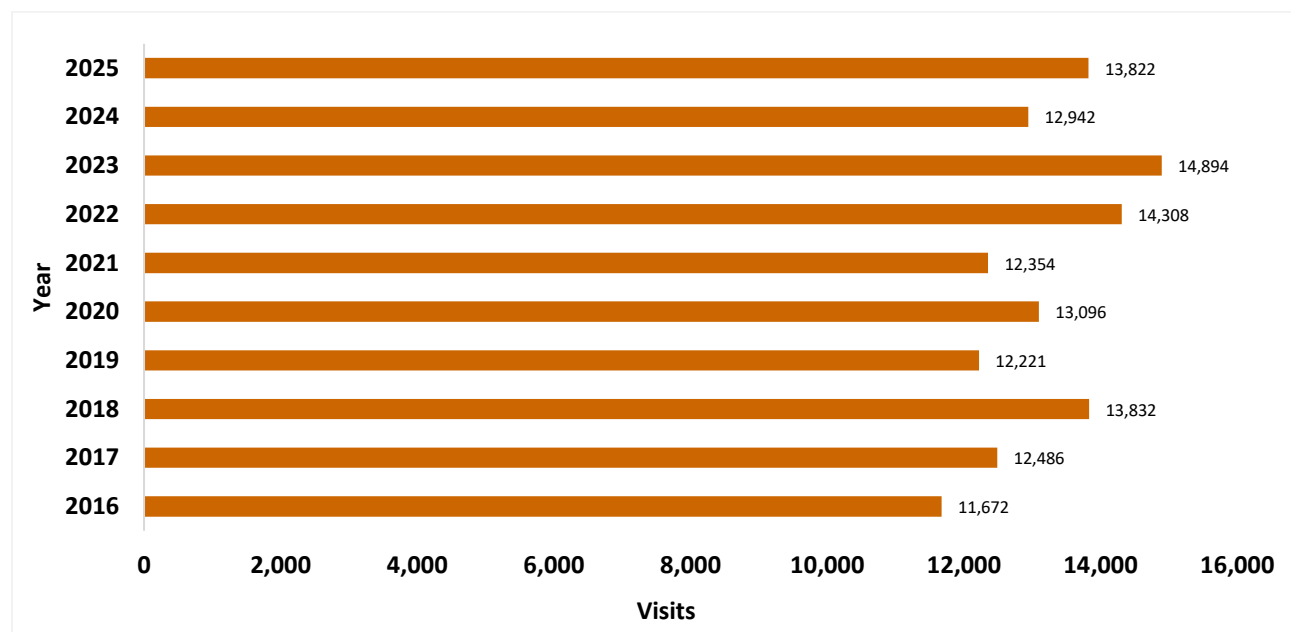

Note

The high number of sessions reported in 2020 was due to special COVID-19 awareness campaigns conducted in schools, separate from regular School Health activities, but all were counted as one.

A school health session refers to a scheduled visit by the School Health Team (nurse and/or other designated health personnel) to a school for the provision of one or more school health activities, including health screening, health education, immunization, follow-up care, or other preventive health

services. A single session may involve multiple students; therefore, the number of sessions does not represent the number of children seen.

Zero values for Glacis and Souvenir. indicate that no school health sessions were reported from these health centres during the respective reporting years. In fact, the specific school health activities of these two health centres (targeting the Glacis and La Misere schools) feature under their respective regional PHC facility (i.e., school health activities of Glacis feature under that of Beau Vallon Health Centre, while that of Souvenir is reflected in either Les Mamelles or Anse Boileau school health sessions.

Key Findings

- Routine infant immunization coverage remained above the national target (95%) for most vaccines.
- Lower coverage was observed for Hepatitis B at birth, the hexavalent vaccine, MMR 2, HPV vaccines, and the Td booster.
- Adolescent vaccination continues to require strengthened follow-up to improve completion rates.

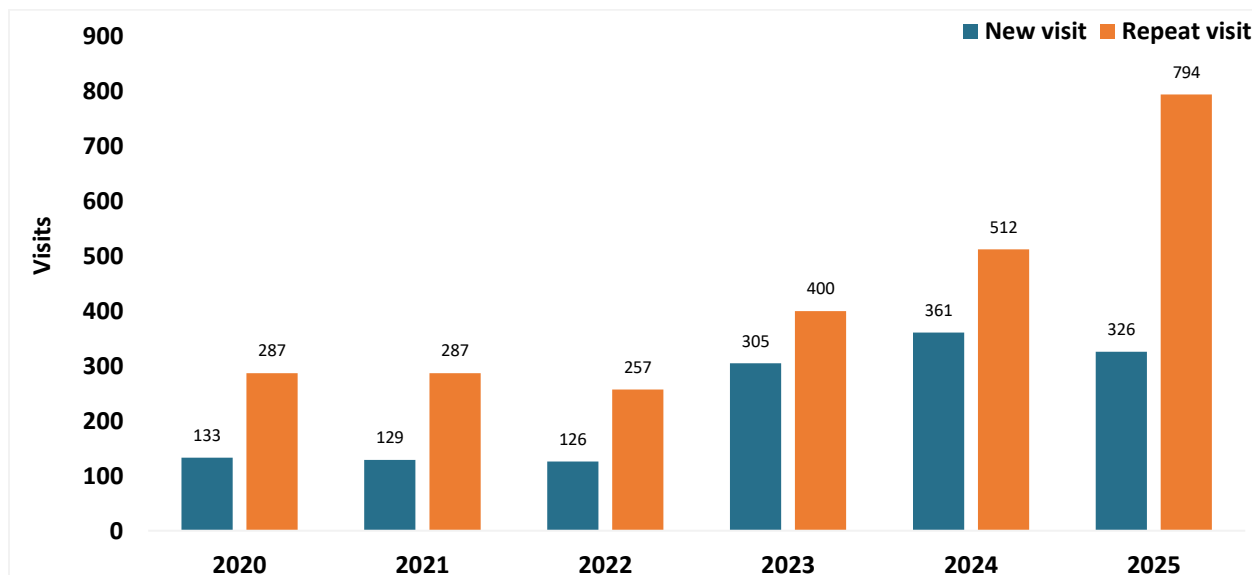

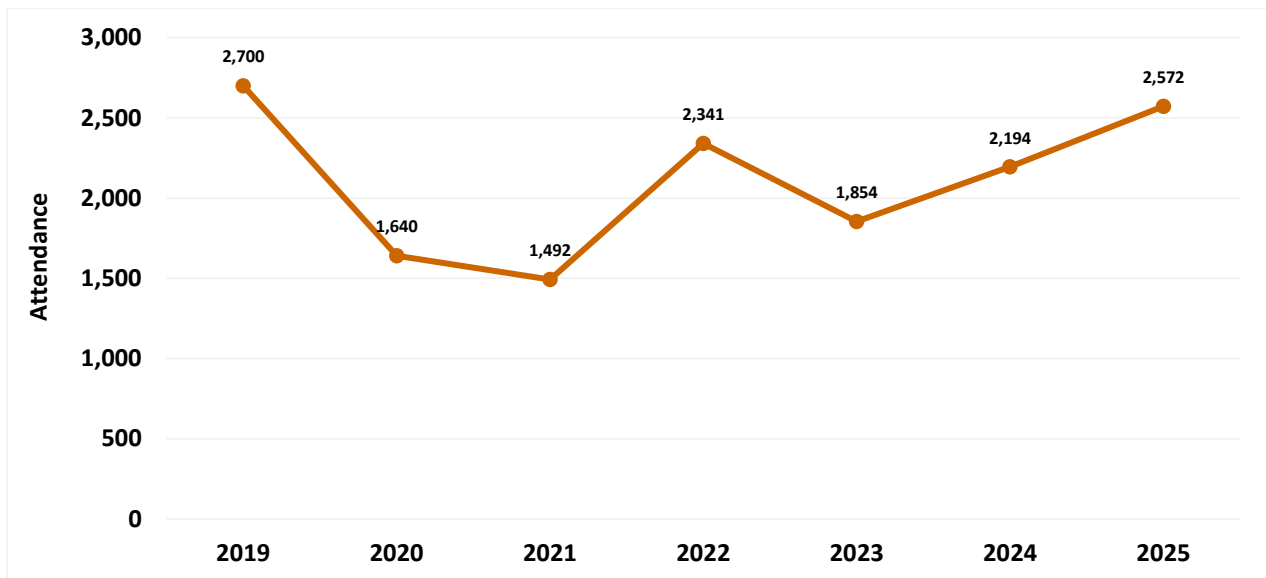

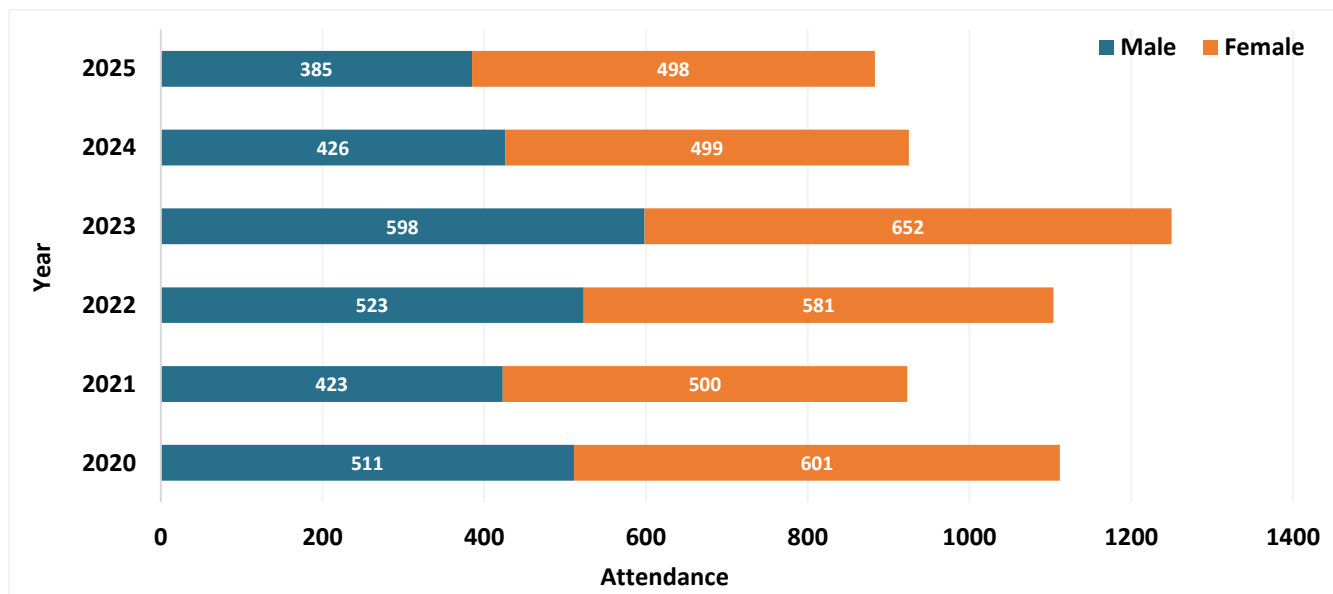

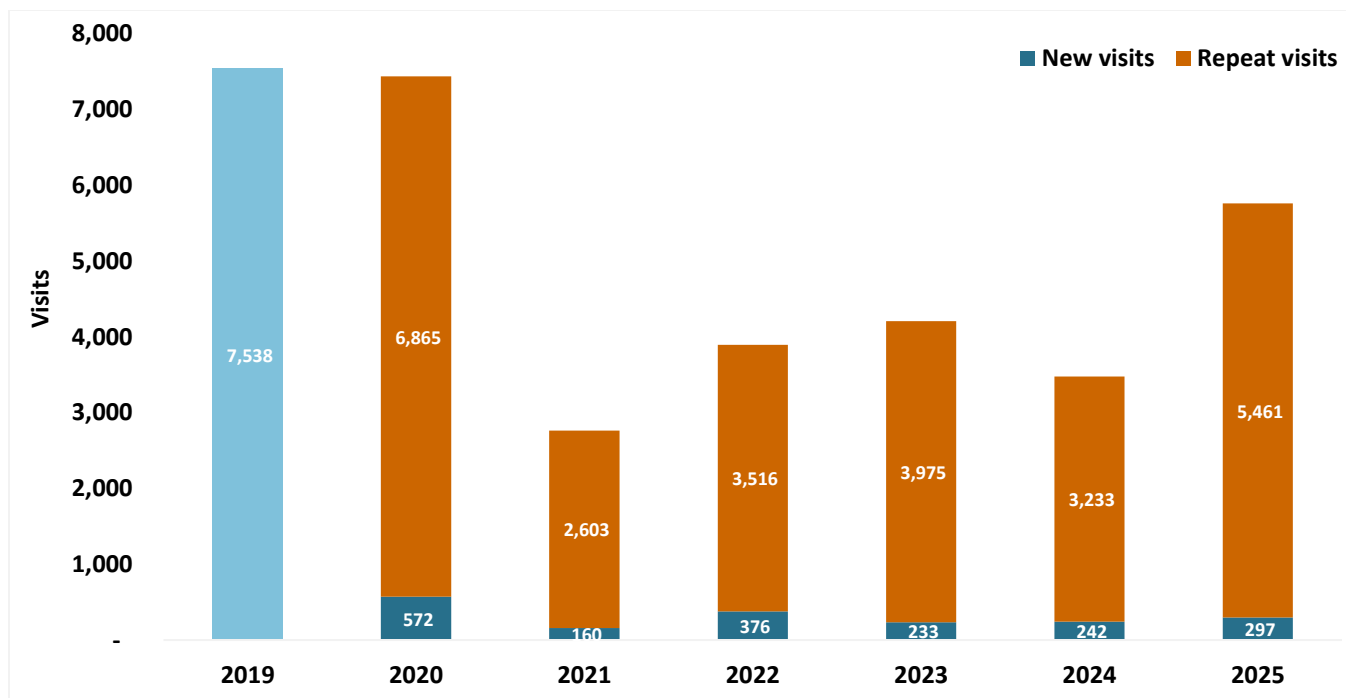

Figure 8 Visits for Orthoprosthesis Services, 2020 – 2025

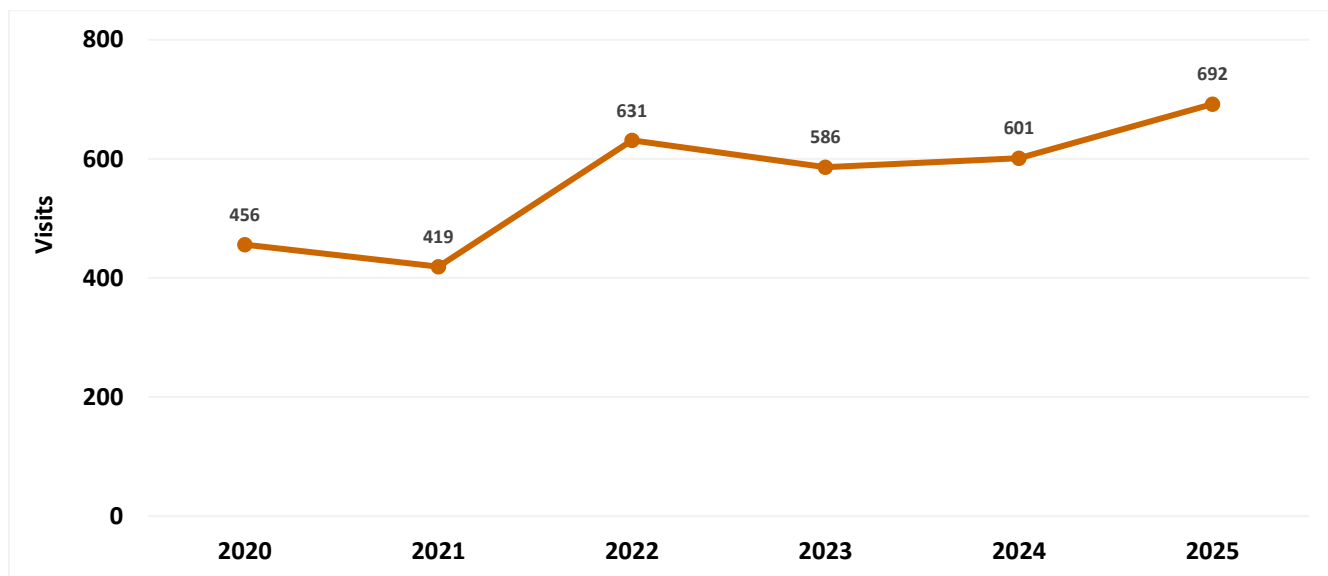

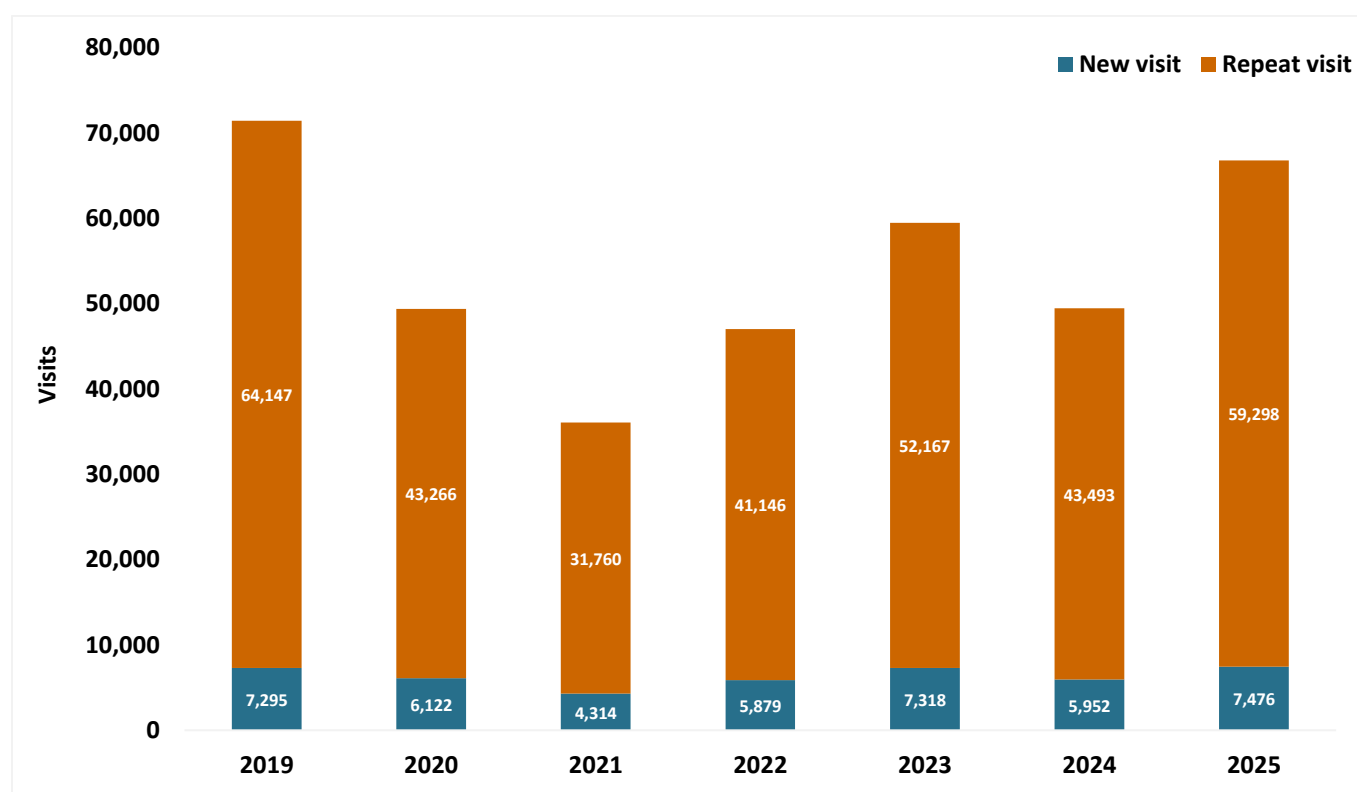

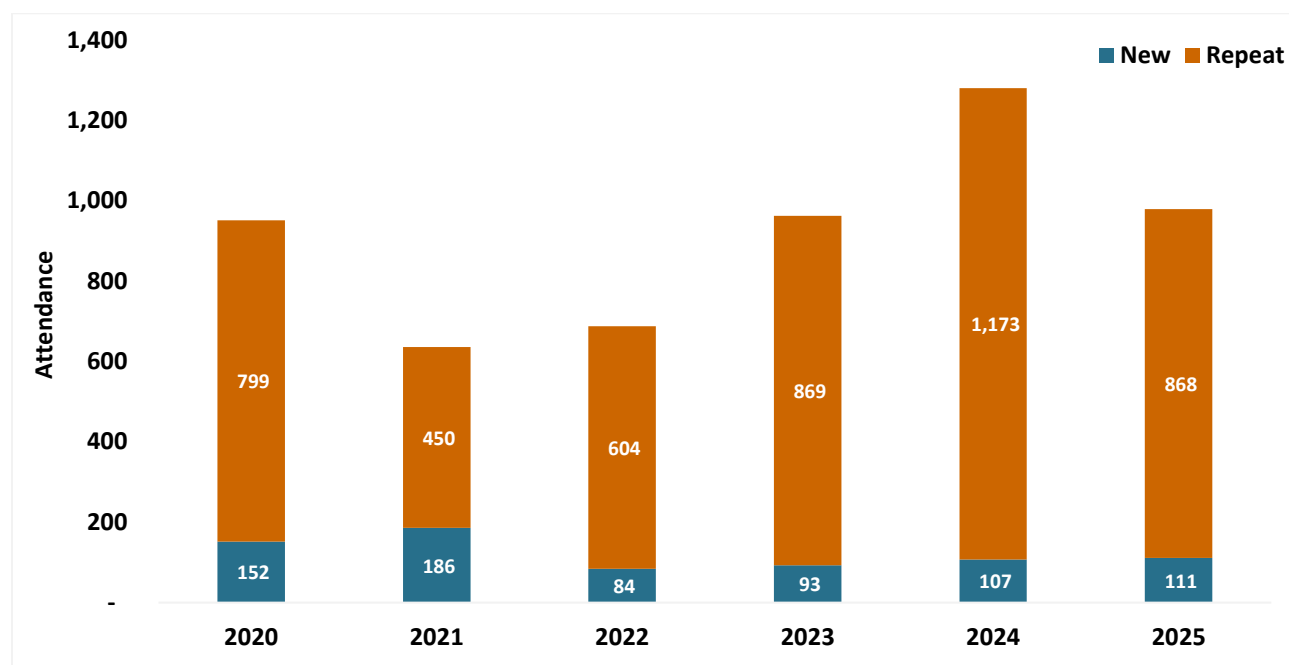

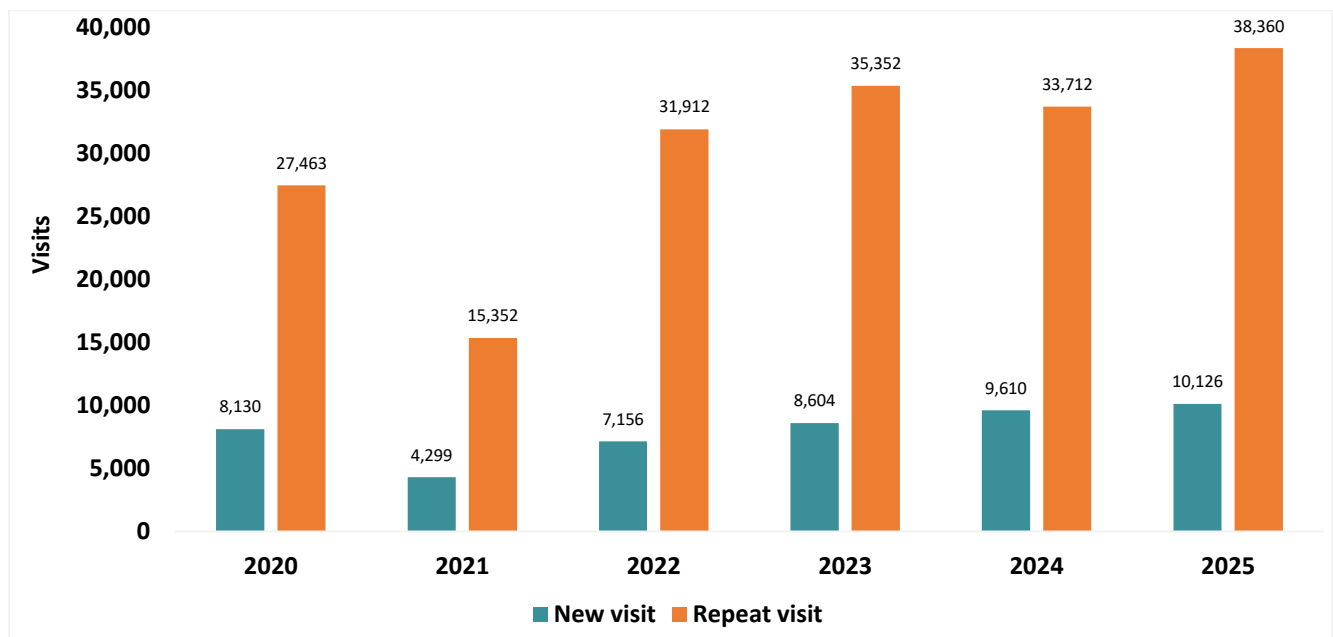

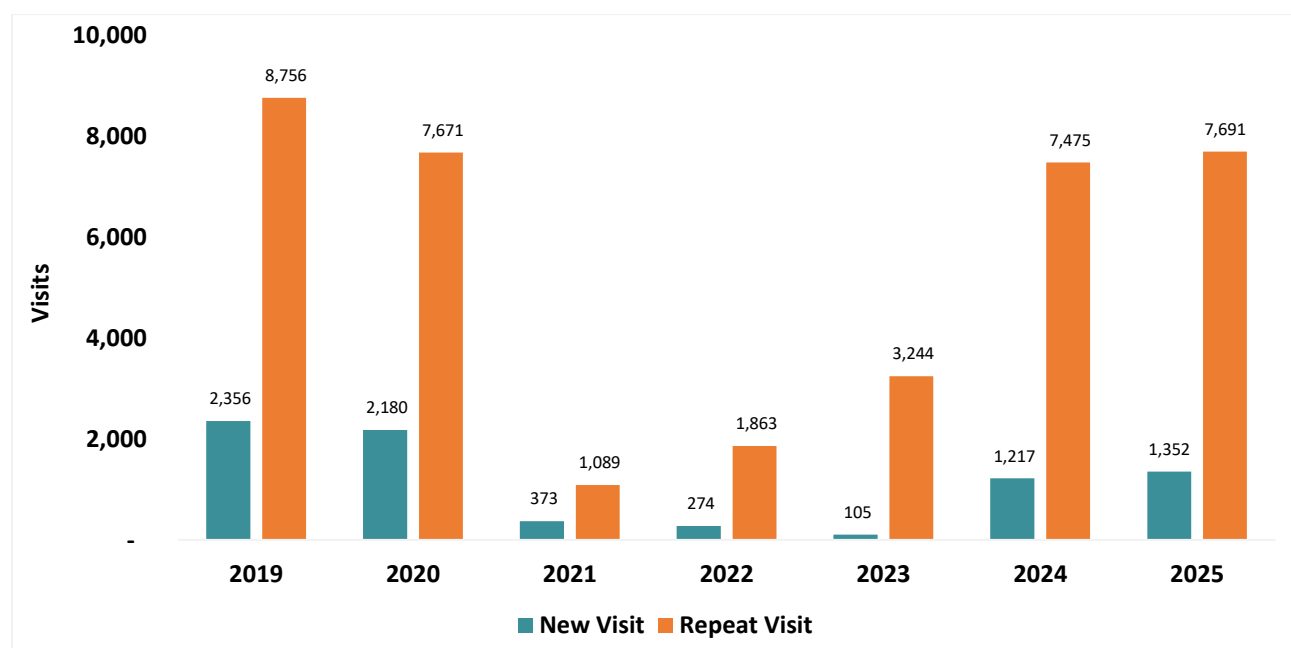

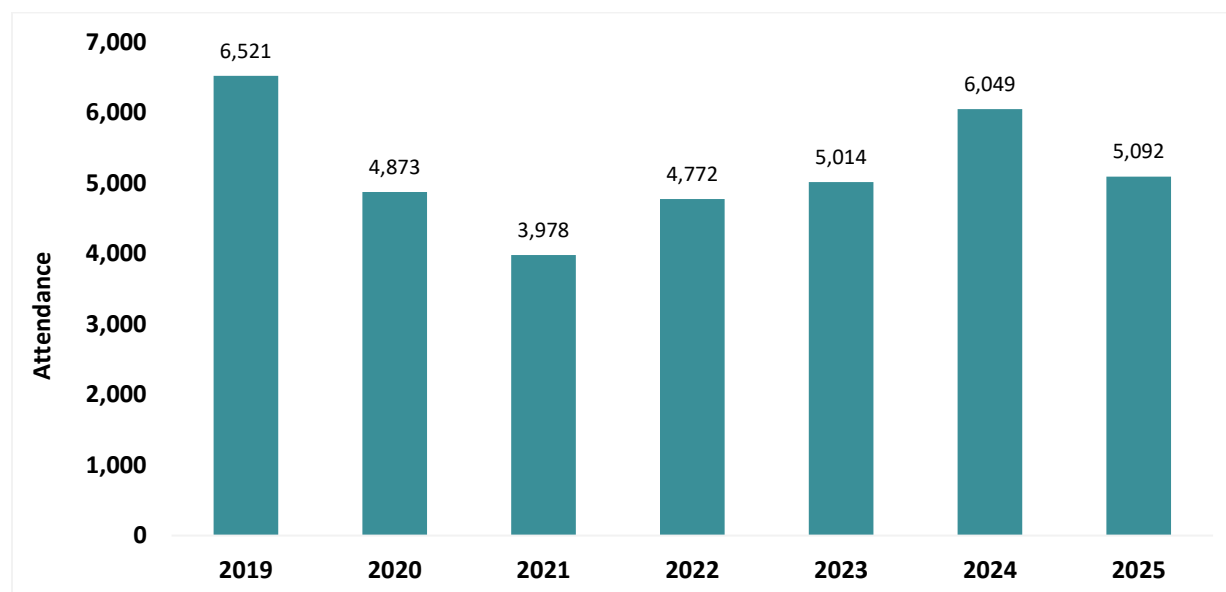
Key Findings

- A total of 5,092 were recorded across Travel, Employment, Other Test, and Assessment in 2025
- Employment-related medical services accounted for the largest share of attendance (2,752, 54.05%). The Food Handlers Medical was the most frequently requested service (1,505

attendances), followed by the Routine Medical Test (1,028) and Validation of food Handlers (826). Together, these represent the 66% of the attendance.

- Other Tests and Assessments contributed 2,144 attendances (42.1%), with Routine Medical Tests, Welfare Assistance (619), and Referral Cases (310) accounting for the major activities within this category.
- Travel-related Services recorded the lowest attendance (196; 3%), with Overseas Training Medicals (188). Accounting for almost all travel-related activities.

Figure 15 OHS Attendance by Dental Units (excluding on-call service), 2024-2025

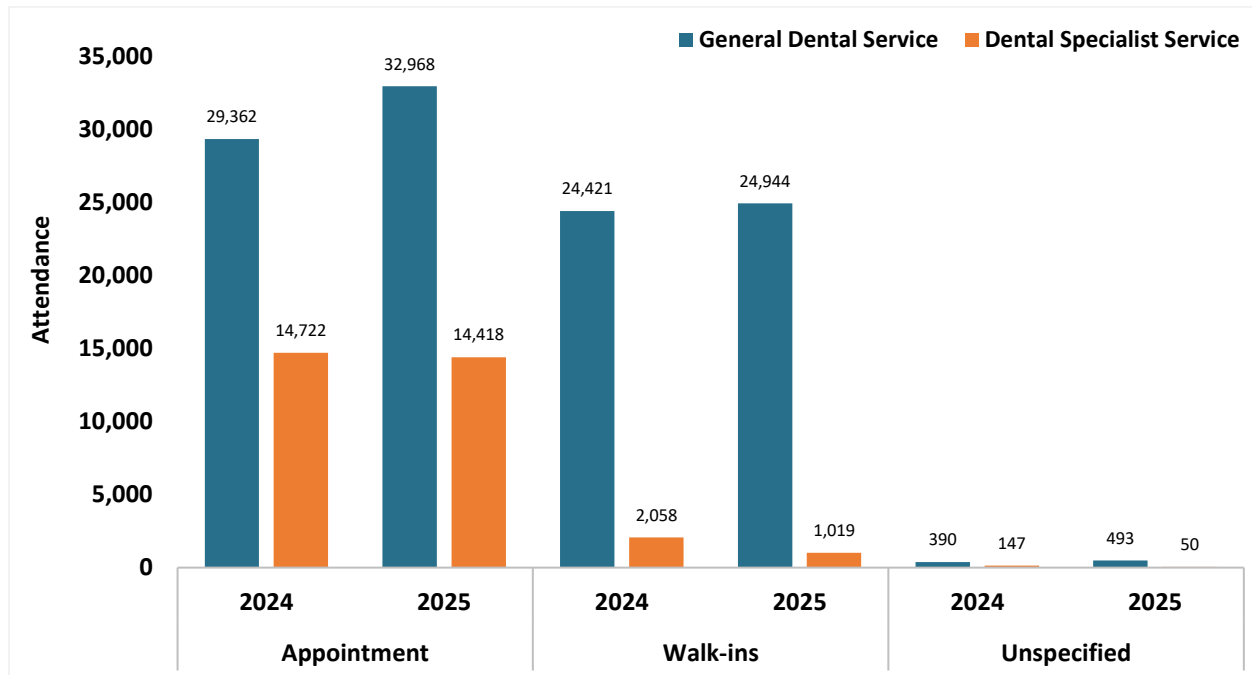

Figure 16 Attendances for Dental Services at Specialist Clinics (Yellow Roof, SH), 2024-2025

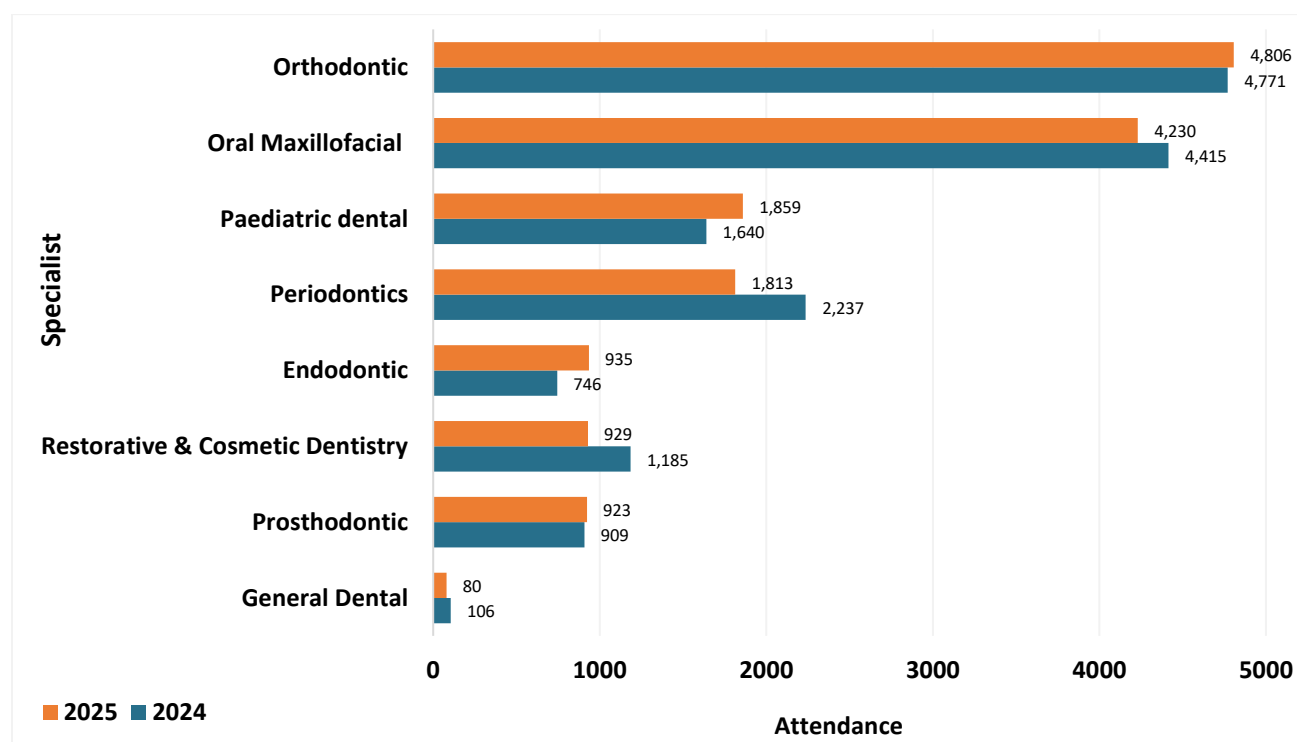

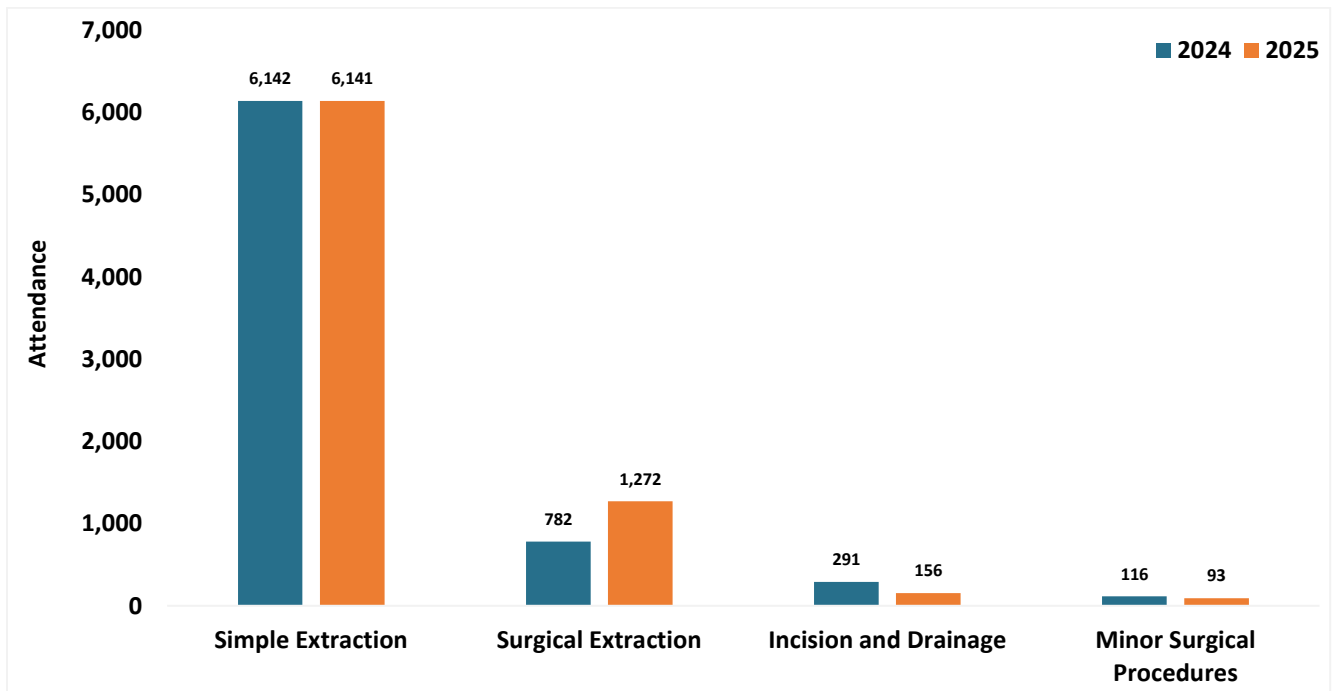
