Update on COVID-19 cases

48 new cases of COVID-19 were recorded since the last update bringing the total number of cases recorded in Seychelles to 2562. They are from samples taken from the 20th to 23rd February.

13 are foreigners and 35 are Seychellois.

32 cases, all Seychellois, met discharge criteria today and have been discharged into convalescence.
