Update on COVID-19 cases

30 new cases of COVID-19 were recorded since the last update bringing the total number of cases recorded in Seychelles to 2592. They are from samples taken on the 23rd and 24th February.

1 is a foreigner and 29 are Seychellois.

Of the 318 active cases, 24 are on Praslin, 7 on La Digue and 287 are on Mahe

215 cases, 185 Seychellois and 20 foreigners, met discharge criteria and have been discharged into convalescence.
